- Abstract (limited to 250 words)

1. All abstracts will be subjected to peer-review by members of the Trauma Aid Europe Scientific Committee.

3. The Conference Scientific Committee will not consider incorrect or incomplete submissions until they are complete and definitive.
4. All abstracts must be submitted in English.
5. Acceptance of abstracts will be based upon both their scientific and technical qualities and the clarity of presentation.
6. Authors are requested to indicate a preference for a specific type of presentation (Symposia or Workshop or Poster).
7. Please note that on behalf of the Trauma Aid Europe Conference Scientific Conference Committee it may not be possible to accept all qualified abstracts for oral presentation.
8. The submission of an abstract, including all relevant parties (co-presenters) connected with the abstract, does not constitute registration for the conference.
Registration requires completion of the appropriate registration form and arrangements for the payments of fees.
